## The TW Steel Dmax 2015 Heats Championships

### Heats

#### Light Heat 1

Richard Lacey took the lead into turn 2, passing Tom Hindley with Ben Leslie taking over from Lacey at turn 5. Chris Hackworth moved into 3<sup>rd</sup> on lap 1 and got onto the back of Lacey as Leslie began to get away at the front. Hackworth got ahead of Lacey to take up 2<sup>nd</sup> and set after Leslie who was 5 seconds clear up the road. Chris Alcock was into 4<sup>th</sup> ahead of Josh King and Tom Golding with King and Golding being hounded by Hindley and Sam Joseph. Leslie was pulling away setting fastest lap after fastest lap, leaving Hackworth on his own in 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9.2 seconds clear of Lacey. Leslie took the win, 5.065 seconds clear of Hackworth, who set the fastest lap on the final lap. Lacey came home in 3<sup>rd</sup> with Alcock and Joseph completing the top 5.

#### Heavy Heat 1

Ben Etchells and Andy Archer led the field into turn 1 as the lights flicked to green with Archer getting ahead. The full course yellow was then quickly brought out to stabilise the race as there was too much contact. Rob Bennett was quick on the restart, passing Lee Henderson and Etchells into turn 2. Bennett was onto the back of Etchells looking for a way past, but was stopped as George Dutfield went up over the kerb at turn 5 and took out Bennett. This left Archer with a healthy lead over Tomasz Zaustowicz and Jamie Pender with Zaustowicz closing in on him as they started the final lap. Zaustowicz got a run out of turn 8 up the hill and slipped past Archer into 9. Zaustowicz took the win ahead of Archer, Pender, David Vincent and Chris Carter.

## Inters Heat 1

Stuart Shearman was jumped by Joe Holmes into turn 1 as the race started and as Sherman held off the chasing pack, Holmes made his escape, building a lead of 4.160 on lap 1 over Simon Joannou, Shearman and Slawomir Piskorz. Shearman kept onto the back of Joannou in the fight for 2<sup>nd</sup> as they were caught by Stuart Foster and Bobby Trundley – Holmes extending his lead to 6.534 seconds. Joannou managed to break away from Shearman as he came under fire from Foster and Trundley. Foster and Trundley kept the pressure on Shearman and eventually broke through, taking and up 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> respectively, but had a tall order to close the gap to Joannou. Holmes started the final lap with a gap of 14.399 seconds over Joannou, Foster, Trundley, Luke Cousins and James Bentley who were all lapping nose-to-tail. Holmes took a comfortable win ahead of Joannou, Trundley, Cousins and Foster.

## Light Heat 2

Tom Golding shot off into turn 1 as those behind were slow to react. Chris Hackworth made quick work from 4<sup>th</sup> to take 2<sup>nd</sup> by turn 5 and set after Golding with Ben Anderson in tow. With clear air, Golding was putting in the fastest laps to build a gap, but Matthew Bees had worked his way past Hackworth and put in the new fastest lap to start closing the gap to Golding. Richard Lacey passed Ben Anderson for 3<sup>rd</sup> with a clean move up the inside into turn 1 but couldn't live with Bees' pace as he pulled away and closed on Golding. The field had spread out by the time the 'last lap' board was displayed with the closest fight on track between Hackworth, Andrew Hunt, Ollie Ursell and Cameron Rodger. Golding took the win by just 0.408 seconds ahead of Bees. Lacey, King and Leslie rounded out the top 5.

Jack Dutfield led the field into turn 1 with Chris Carter and Vinod Hirani tucked up under his exhaust. George Dutfield had worked his way into 3<sup>rd</sup> by the time the field emerged from the bottom of the hill with a lunge on Carter for 2<sup>nd</sup> at turn 9 not quite paying off as he ran wide. This allowed Jack to build a small lead as George got ahead of Carter a lap later with James Brett-Pitt following him past. Jamie Pender had worked his way into 4<sup>th</sup> and was on the back of Brett-Pitt, passing him with a run out of the final corner to take 3<sup>rd</sup>. George Dutfield was closing on Jack as the time ticked away and as he got onto the back of him, Jack was defending to hold him off as they started the final lap 0.286 seconds apart. Pender was catching the pair of them, but ran out of time as Jack took the chequered flag ahead of George Dutfield, Pender, Brett-Pitt and Carter.

## Inters Heat 2

The field filtered through the opening corners cleanly with Stuart Foster in pursuit of Sam Harris at the end of lap 1. 2<sup>nd</sup> came the lead at the end of lap 2 with Andrew Knapp running in 3<sup>rd</sup> bringing Luke Cousins and Bobby Trundle with him as he looked to close the gap to the leading pair. Foster had just a kart length between himself and Harris keeping himself just out of range of an attack from Harris. Trundle had made his way into 3<sup>rd</sup> ahead of Knapp and was quickly onto the back of Foster and Harris along with Knapp and Cousins as the top 5 started the penultimate lap 1.512 seconds apart. Trundle passed Harris for 2<sup>nd</sup> with Harris dropping down to 6<sup>th</sup> as Trundle, Knapp, Joe Holmes and Cousins passed him. Trundle grabbed the lead from Foster on the final lap, taking the chequered flag by 1.015 seconds from Foster, Knapp, Holmes and Harris.

## Light Heat 3

Sam Bennett and Jose Ignacio-Dengra led the field around on the rolling up lap as the green lights came on to start the race. Ollie Ursell grabbed the lead at the start, holding off Andrew Hunt and Shane Carrington as they filed down the hill towards turn 6. As the re-emerged it was Ursell from Josh King, Andrew Hunt and Chris Alcock, all separated by 3.8 seconds. King set after Ursell at the front, escaping from Hunt and Alcock behind him, setting a new fastest lap with a 1:06.888 on lap 3 to bring the gap down to 0.325 seconds. King hit the front on lap 4, and got his head down to start edging away from Ursell, setting a string of fastest laps. Tom Golding had made his way into 3<sup>rd</sup> ahead of Richard Lacey towards the end of the race as King took the chequered flag from Ursell, Golding, Lacey and Ben Anderson.

## Heavy Heat 3

Jamie Pender led the pack by the time it reach turn 4 as contact throughout the pack caused David Vincent to be facing the wrong way on the run down to turn 2. Pender was quick to capitalise on the drama as he pulled out an early lead over Tomasz Zaustowicz, Jack Dutfield, Ian Dutfield and Chris Carter. Carter went for a move up the inside of Jack Dutfield at the final corner, but ran wide on the exit, allowing Dutfield to draw alongside as they approached turn 1. Carter hung it around the outside and made it stick to take 2<sup>nd</sup> and then set after Zaustowicz, getting on terms with him a lap later to begin looking for a way past. Carter made quick work of Zaustowicz, passing him for 2<sup>nd</sup> at the bottom of the hill on lap 5 with leader Pender next. Rob Bennett was making steady progress through the field to sit in 4<sup>th</sup> ahead of Vincent who was recovering from being turned around at the start. Carter claimed the lead on the penultimate lap, dropping Pender to 2<sup>nd</sup> and looked to get away with a little over a lap remaining. Carter took the win from Pender by 1.484 seconds with Zaustowicz coming home in 3<sup>rd</sup>, Vincent in 4<sup>th</sup> and Bennett in 5<sup>th</sup>.

## Inters Heat 3

Gibson took over at the front by turn 5 and pulled out 1.075 seconds on the opening lap ahead of Rees, Joe Holmes and Allan Curtis. Holmes closed down the lead, passed Gibson and set a new fastest lap on lap 2 as he got away from the fight for 2<sup>nd</sup> between Gibson, Curtis and James Bentley. Curtis took 2<sup>nd</sup> into turn 9 a lap later, but was now 3.222 seconds behind Holmes who had shot off down the road. Gibson was now heading a train of 5 with Luke Cousins, Stuart Foster, Bobby Trundle and Sam Harris all tucked up behind him. Holmes continued to get away as Curtis had Bentley all over his bumper with the time to chequered, ticking away. Holmes took the win from Curtis, Bentley, Foster and Cousins.

## Heavy Final

Chris Carter quickly moved into 2<sup>nd</sup> as the field darted behind the hill at turn 6 with Carter all over the back of Zaustowicz at the end of the opening lap. David Vincent had moved into 3<sup>rd</sup> with George Dutfield tucked under his exhaust as Zaustowicz began to put some distance between himself and Carter on the second lap. Pender was running in 5<sup>th</sup> with Jack Dutfield a kart length behind with Rob Bennett a further kart length behind with Zaustowicz extending his lead as he put in a series of fastest laps. Vincent was keeping George Dutfield at an arm's length and out of attacking range with Vincent setting a new fastest lap of the race on lap 5 – a 1:06.341. Despite their close proximity, Vincent and George Dutfield were still edging towards Carter with Pender keeping Bennett just behind him in the fight for 5<sup>th</sup> with nothing between them. Zaustowicz was cruising away at the front putting in more fastest laps to put himself well out of reach, appearing from the bottom of the hill with his visor, flashing green and blue under the flood lights to start the final lap. George Dutfield was still hustling Vincent for 3<sup>rd</sup>, but all eyes were on Zaustowicz as he took the win by 3.705 seconds from Carter to complete the double for the day. Vincent completed the podium ahead of George Dutfield and Bennett.

Holmes appeared from the bottom of the hill for the first time with what appeared to be a comfortable lead from Foster and Trundley. Trundley got a run into turn 1 with Foster trying to hang it around the outside with some minor contact as Foster turned in. This allowed Luke Cousins to slip past the pair of them into turn 2. This was making Holmes' getaway and easy one as those behind him tripped over each other and held each other up. Trundley was hounding Cousins to try and regain 2<sup>nd</sup> with Holmes' now looking out of reach as he was 4 seconds up the road on lap 3. Foster was being caught by Allan Curtis in the fight for 4<sup>th</sup> with Foster just keeping Curtis out of striking distance. Curtis went for a move up the inside at the final corner with Foster holding it around the outside all the way down the start/finish straight, through turn 1 and down to turn 2, keeping Curtis behind him. Trundley had finally got ahead of Cousins on lap 8 to take 2<sup>nd</sup> with a few minutes left on the clock to allow Trundley the chance of closing down the 3.3 second lead to Holmes at the front.
